Our Mission

BCC is a land trust dedicated to the preservation of environmentally sensitive lands in Northwest Florida. Our goal is to acquire land that will enhance the present and future natural resources of this area. With our rapid growth rate, these lands and natural resources are under constant pressure and threat of development.

Protected Lands

Tumble Creek Preserve

67 acres in Washington County consisting of diverse sandhill trees, shrubs, and wetland species. The preserve includes a small creek.

King Family Preserve

A heavily wooded wetland, this beautiful 30-acre tract is a remnant of the large band of mid-city wetlands that once existed before heavy development occurred.

Juniper Headwaters Preserve

40 acres of mixed upland and wetland near Fountain.

Doreen Miley Holder Preserve

12.5 acres south of Freeport. Bear Creek runs through the preserve, which was donated to honor a family member.

Talkington Nature Preserve

10 acres in Lynn Haven. Habitat for the Panama City crayfish and other wetland species.



Audubon Nature Preserve

30 acre wetland off State Avenue. A boardwalk, gazebo, and info kiosk make a place to relax and observe nature.

Mary Ola Reynolds Miller Palm Preserve

1/3 acre donated to BCC on Beach Drive. Serves as an important storm water retention area and is home to 70 native palm trees and a wildlife garden.

Richard Jennings Preserve

6 acres of inner city wetland turning into uplands, between Hwy. 231 & 19th Street.

Marjorie's Magical Marsh-Symone's

Sanctimonious Swamp

10 acres on E. Lakeland Drive, east of Deerpoint Lake, provides habitat for wetland species.
